

Reading / Language Arts

- TN is predominately a reading test
 - Reading passages are given first, then students are asked comprehension questions
 - Students are often directed to refer back to the reading passage and cite examples
 - This section of the test is INTEGRATED yet separate. Questions call for knowledge & skills in both areas AND questions are scored in two ways to give scores for each area.
-  This symbol means that LA skills are going to be assessed: spelling, capital letters, punctuation, sentence structure, and paragraph formation will ALL be evaluated
 - Written responses are 'essay' type
 - DOL/DLP are great ways to prep students for questions on this part of the test
 - Editing symbols are different from Literacy Place.
